**Good Scouts are not born; good Scouts are made by programs like the Brownsea Island Adventure. Designed for younger boys new to Scouting or transitioning from Webelos, the Brownsea Island Adventure teaches the patrol method, basic Scout skills, and gets boys excited about Scouting.**

**Scouts are divided into Patrols of 8 to 10 boys and paired with a Life or Eagle Scout who serves as their guide for the week. Together they learn the essential skills of Scouting and complete many of the requirements for Tenderfoot through First Class through hands-on interactive lessons, daily Scouting competitions between Patrols, and a special overnight experience.**

**Created in the spirit of the original Brownsea Island Camp established by Lord Baden-Powell back in 1907, the Brownsea Island Adventure is a fun and educational way to give Scouts a solid foundation to begin their trail to Eagle.**
